What a wet half term week. We really need some nice sun and wind to dry up the fields. We welcome Gina Porter to the staff team this month in the new role of Equine Operations and Development Manager. Gina will be responsible for continuing the smooth running of the Equine side of the Centre and developing wider equine activities to help our funds. Income from Riding for the Disabled lessons only covers 50% of the cost of each lesson. The Centre needs to fund the remaining 50% by nondisabled riding activities and fundraising. Engaging with horse owners to ride their own horses at the Centre in return for a donation is an important part of our financial planning. Long term plans to improve our offer to current riders and encourage new ones include an all-weather track around the perimeter of the land and an improved x country course. We will also be introducing Vaulting and Carriage Driving. In the short term a new roof is vital. We have £60,000 towards the £70,000 needed to commit to the work. If we do not use the money before October we will lose £50,000 (it is a time restricted grant offer) and the plan will halt. If anyone has any ideas for fundraising or contacts that may reduce the cost of the roof please do get in touch with Jane. Obviously we also still need every penny we can raise to continue to repay the bank loan taken out to buy the land we use. Volunteers, riders and parents have been hard at work supporting the Centre's fundraising activities recently. Abseiling, working on the stand at Badminton, marshalling the Badminton Fun Ride and bucket collecting have all been going on among other things. Thank you to everyone involved in fundraising, we could not operate without you.

During the RDA holidays our instructors and arena volunteers take a well-earned break. I hope you are refreshing and recharging your batteries as we will be very pleased to see you all back next week. We never forget that what you do in the arena with our riders is what we are all here for.
