The Avon Riding Centre for the Disabled is a registered charity based in Henbury, Bristol, which supports up to 200 disabled people a week in riding lessons and sensory sessions. These allow them to access the unique physiotherapy and psychological benefits of riding and spending time around horses.

Giving this therapy costs us £345,000 per year. We raise £155,000 from charging a nominal fee to our disabled riders, and also from our commercial riding school, Bristol Horse Riding. This leaves us with £190,000 to raise from other sources.

To help us to raise some of this money, we are hosting an Auction of Promises on 26th May 2017. I would be grateful if you would consider donating a prize to our cause.
